<b>3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION</b>

<b>4. FIRST AID MEASURES</b>	
<b>EYES:-</b>	Irrigate copiously with clean, fresh water for at least 15 minutes. Seek medical attention.

<b>6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES</b>	
Methods for Clean up:-	Absorb significant spills using inert absorbent material. Place in a container for disposal in accordance with local authority Regulations. Wear PPE as specified in section 8. After cleaning, wash away traces with water.
Environmental Precautions:-	Do not allow significant amounts of the product to enter drains.

<b>7. HANDLING &amp; STORAGE</b>	
Handling:-	Read the product instruction label before use. Ensure adequate general ventilation in areas of work. Do not breathe vapours or spray mist. Use only in recommended concentration. Wear personal protective equipment as shown in section 8. Avoid high temperatures (above 200 degrees C). Do not spray onto hot or incandescent materials. Use only low pressure spray (below 4.1 bar). Never return used product to the container. Avoid skin / eye contact. Always wash thoroughly after handling chemicals.
Storage:-	Do not mix with any other chemicals other than those advised on the product label or by Craftex representatives. Store upright between 5 & 25°C in a dry well ventilated place, in original container. Keep tightly closed.
